WELCOME

We invite your organization to submit nominations to The 2026 (24th Annual) American Business Awards®, the top honors in the United States for achievement in the workplace.

All organizations operating in the US are eligible to submit nominations to the ABAs: large and small, public and private, for-profit and non-profit. Nominations may be submitted by individuals or organizations. The 2025 competition attracted more than 3,700 nominations from organizations of all types, all across America.

The Stevie® Award trophy, the prize that is conferred in the ABAs and all other Stevie Award programs, is one of the world's most coveted prizes. Many of America's largest and most famous organizations have won Stevie Awards. Most of our winners each year are small and midsize organizations that are still growing and building their brands, however.

This booklet explains how to prepare and submit nominations to the ABAs. The first important step to entering is to review the categories and to choose the categories in which you'll participate. You'll find new categories sprinkled through the various category groups, and we encourage you to explore them.

Eligibility extends from January 1, 2024, through the date on which you submit your nominations. Nominations that won in the 2025 ABAs may be resubmitted for consideration in the 2026 ABAs. If they have not been updated, they must be submitted to categories different from those in which they won.

In these pages you will find explanations of the submission requirements for all of these categories, and an outline of how to submit your entries through our website at ABA.StevieAwards.com. All of this information is also available on the website. All Stevie Award placements will be announced on April 23, prior to the June 9 awards banquet in New York.

We hope your organization will submit entries to The 2026 American Business Awards. Please don't hesitate to contact us with your questions about how to participate.

AWARDS PROCESS

Many of the judges are invited, and are former Stevie® Award winners. Other professionals apply to judge, and if accepted are assigned categories by Stevie Awards staff, based on their industry, function, and experience. To apply to be a judge for The 2026 American Business Awards,® you need to click here. Once you login, you will need to verify you have American Business Awards® program selected in the system and click on "Apply to Judge" to open the judge application.

Judging of entries will be conducted over two months, from February to April, by judging committees focused on the main category groups. Each committee will have 10-30 members. Judges will be both volunteers and invitees. Judges' average scores will determine the Stevie Award winners. Every category in which there is at least one nomination with a final average score of at least 7.75 out of a possible 10 will have a Gold Stevie Award winner. Otherwise, the nomination with the highest average score in a category will win the Gold Stevie Award trophy in that category. Every other nomination in the category with an average of at least 8.0 will win a Silver Stevie Award medals. Other nominations with an average score of at least 7.75 will win Bronze Stevie Award medals.

During judging, each entry is reviewed and rated by no fewer than five (5) judges. All entries are viewed and rated at the judges' convenience online. Rating is done on a scale of 1-10.

All judges' comments on entries will be available in entrants' entry-submission accounts when Stevie Award winners are announced.

The veracity of claims made in winning entries may be audited. Any entry found to contain false or misleading information will be disqualified. Gold Stevie-winning entries will be published on The American Business Awards® website. Winners will have the opportunity to redact any confidential or non-public information from their entries before publication.

BEST OF THE ABA AWARDS

The Best of the ABA Awards are bestof-competition prizes that will be awarded to the organizations that submit the best body of work to the competition, in their own name or in the names of one or more clients. The winners of these prizes will be awarded the <u>Grand Stevie® Award</u> trophy.

These awards cannot be applied for directly. They will be determined by a points system based on the total number of awards won in the ABAs, with a Gold Stevie win counting for 3 points, a Silver Stevie for 2 points, and a Bronze Stevie counting for 1.5. Points cannot be counted more than once in calculating Best of the ABA winners (i.e., points won by an agency in its client's name cannot be counted a second time in the agency's name).

Best of the ABA winners are awarded the exclusive right to use a unique Grand Stevie Award winner logo.





HOW TO ENTER

Visit the website at

or click the READY? ENTER NOW button
at the bottom of any page in this kit.

Complete the registration form to create the account in which you'll submit your nominations, or login to your existing account, if you already have one.

Within your entry-submission account, select The American Business Awards from the program drop-down in the top right of your screen.

Follow the instructions to create and save your first entry. Repeat the process as necessary to create and save additional entries.

When you've created all of the entries you will submit, click the check boxes next to their titles, then click the SUBMIT SELECTED NOMINATIONS button to begin the submission process.

Review and agree to the Terms and Conditions of Entry, and choose how to pay your entry fees.





Entry fees are summarized in a PDF document which you may <u>download here</u>. A separate fee is required for each category in which an entry is submitted. No refunds will be made after February 10, 2026. Entries submitted after February 10, 2026 will be assessed a late fee of \$55 (per entry) in addition to the entry fee, but will not be penalized in any way in the judging.

There are no other required fees. Stevie Award winners receive a complimentary winners package with winner logos, graphics, press release templates, and more. Attending the award ceremony and receiving your Stevie Award in the mail are optional. You do not have to do either to keep your title as a Stevie winner.

ACCEPTABLE PAYMENT METHODS

- Credit Card: American Express, MasterCard, and Visa
- Check: Written on a U.S. bank in U.S. dollars, payable to Stevie Awards, Inc.
- Wire: Payment in U.S. dollars may be wired. After you have submitted your entries, you will have access to an invoice with wire transfer instructions.





2026 CATEGORIES

The American Business Awards® accept entries in many different types of categories.

Nominations that won in the 2025 ABAs may be resubmitted for consideration in the 2026 ABAs. If they have been updated with recent achievements, they may be submitted to the same categories in which they won. If they have not been updated, they must be submitted to categories different from those in which they won.

Determine Who or What You Want to Nominate, and in Which Categories

Decide which individuals, departments, teams, achievements, solutions, or implementations in your organization you wish to nominate, then select the most appropriate categories for those entries. Submit Your Entries By the Entry Deadline

The early-bird entry deadlines are November 19, 2025 and December 16, 2025, through which entry fees are discounted. The final entry deadline will be February 10, 2026. Late entries will be accepted through March 4, 2026 with payment of a \$55 late fee per entry.

The following are the terms and conditions of entry to The 2026 American Business Awards®. By submitting entries to the competition you assent that you have read and agree to abide by these terms and conditions.

Failure to comply with these Terms & Conditions will render your entries ineligible. Entry fees will not be refunded.







ENTRY PREPARATION TIPS

Write Your Entries
Offline Before
Submitting Them

Write your entries offline to keep a permanent record. Then, submit them through our simple online system. Avoid writing directly online, as technical issues with your computer or our system could cause you to lose your work.

2 Supporting Materials and Links

For most categories, supporting files or URLs are optional. However, we strongly recommend including at least your organization's website URL so judges can access basic information about your organization.

How to Submit Entries for Multiple Clients

PR and marketing agencies submitting for multiple clients should create one account under the agency's name with agency contact details. For each nomination you create you will be able to specify the name and location of the organization you are nominating.

5 Test Your Links

If you include links to videos, images, or other materials, be sure to test them before submitting. Preview your entry and click the links to ensure they work and show the intended content to the judges.

Video Entries
and Other
Media Materials

Attachments should be directly downloadable and easy to access. For videos, use a YouTube, Vimeo, or similar link that plays instantly. If that's not possible, upload the video file instead.

7 Giving Titles to Your Entries

When choosing a title for your entries, don't include the category name — judges will see it. For individual nominations, simply use the person's name and job title unless additional text adds meaningful context. Keep titles simple.

Well-Written and Succinct

Stevie-winning entries are clear, focused, and modest.
Highlight a few key accomplishments in detail rather than listing many briefly, and keep the writing concise.

THE STEVIE® AWARD

The Stevie Award trophy is one of the world's most coveted prizes. Since 2002 the Gold Stevie Award has been conferred for achievement in the workplace to organizations and individuals in more than 70 nations and territories.

The name Stevie is taken from the name Stephen, which is derived from the Greek for "crowned."

The crystal pyramid held aloft by Stevie represents the hierarchy of human needs, a system often represented as a pyramid that was developed in the 1960s by psychologist Abraham Maslow, who observed that after their basic needs are met, human beings seek the esteem of their peers.
