**Company Description:** Meralco is the largest private sector electric distribution utility company in the Philippines covering 39 cities and 72 municipalities. Its franchise area of over 9,685 km2 is just 3% of the total land area of the Philippines, but accounts for 55% of the country’s electricity output.

Now on its 122<sup>nd</sup> year, Meralco is the Philippines’ largest electric distribution utility, and its franchise area is the seat of economic, political, and social activity in the country. It provides energy to 39 cities and 72 municipalities and serves over eight million customers, which collectively account for half of the country’s GDP.

Through its subsidiaries and affiliates, Meralco is also involved in power generation, after-the-meter services like energy efficiency, and beyond-energy services such as digital payments, engineering, construction, logistics, and telecommunications.

Meralco’s vision is to be a world-class energy solutions provider. Its mission is to provide customers the best-value energy solutions—reliably, affordably, superbly, and sustainably. Its corporate values are excellence, customer centricity, sustainability, integrity, innovation, *malasakit* (caring for others), and *bayanihan* (community spirit). Meralco is committed to ensuring that electricity continually flows from the grid to its customers—to light up homes and offices, power industries, and energize the economy.

Meralco has placed sustainability at the heart of its business by establishing its sustainability agenda—“Powering the Good Life”—which is deeply rooted in the United Nations’ Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs) and is marked by a distinctive focus on four pillars: Power, Planet, People, and Prosperity.

Through its sustainability agenda, “Powering the Good Life”, Meralco has embedded sustainability into its DNA—implementing key initiatives with significant achievements:

Power

- Long-term Sustainability Strategy: Meralco's just, orderly, and affordable transition to clean energy, with goal to become coal-free before 2050.
- Built attributable renewable energy (RE) capacity of 1,826MW (vs. 1,500MW target by 2030).
- Secured RE supply of 2,282MW (vs. 1,500MW target by 2030).]
- Launched landmark project to build world’s largest integrated solar and battery storage facility—set to deliver 3,500MW solar power and 4,500MWh battery storage, to displace 4.3M tons of coal, and to power 2.4M households annually.

Planet

- Green Mobility: Electrified 6% of vehicle fleet (vs. government-mandated 5%).
- Race to Zero Waste: Achieved 95% waste diversion rate (vs. 17% pre-program).
- Greening The Network: Implemented 100% transition to biodegradable ester oil (vs. mineral oil) distribution transformers.
- One For Trees: Planted 2.7M trees (2.3M previous year).

People

- #Mbrace Diversity and Inclusion: Increased female workforce representation to 23% (vs. 13% global energy sector average).

Prosperity

- Education Reach: Energized 304 off-grid schools.
- Water Access: Provided for 837 households.
- Healthcare Access: Energized 6 health facilities.
- Livelihood Productivity: Energized 5 agricultural facilities for cooperatives.
- Disaster Resilience: Trained 286 cooperative/community members.
- Meralco Supplier Sustainability Scorecard: Integrated sustainability in 100% of supplier assessments.

Moreover, Meralco ensures robust sustainability governance and reporting:

- Board-level Sustainability Committee and Sustainability Champions (30 executives).
- Sustainability metrics representing 10% of top corporate KPIs.
- Annual Sustainability and Integrated Reports (since 2019), all with international/local awards.
