The company's purpose is to “Build for business to prosper and for communities to thrive,” a commitment reflected in its approach to providing innovative, sustainable, and high-quality construction services. Specializing in heavy industries, light industries, infrastructure, and maintenance projects, Aboitiz Construction offers a wide range of end-to-end solutions, including design, construction, and asset management.

As a full-service engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) company, Aboitiz Construction holds a prestigious PCAB Quadruple A license, the highest contractor classification awarded by the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board. This enables the company to undertake complex and large-scale projects with exceptional quality and efficiency.

With over 800 completed projects across the country, Aboitiz Construction has earned a reputation for operational excellence, safety, and sustainability. The company is ISO-certified, ensuring the highest standards in every project it delivers. Aboitiz Construction’s commitment to employee empowerment, local talent development, and community-building initiatives further underscores its significant role in advancing the Philippine construction industry and contributing to national progress.

Aboitiz Construction’s achievements since 2023 set it apart as a leader in the Philippine construction industry. The company’s 82% on-time project completion rate and 94% of projects delivered within target margins demonstrate unmatched reliability and cost efficiency. These results are amplified by a 500% increase in awarded contracts, showcasing Aboitiz Construction’s resilience in a competitive market.

Safety and customer satisfaction are core to its success, with the company achieving 27 million continuous safe man-hours and a 100% satisfaction rate from clients. Aboitiz Construction also leads in innovation, implementing real-time remote monitoring and in-house digital solutions like EquiMax, resulting in a 30% increase in machine control efficiency.

In finance, the company’s growth in the maintenance business—securing 14 new clients and generating ₱650M in 2024 revenue—signals its ability to diversify. With a projected ₱1B revenue by 2026, Aboitiz Construction is on track to expand its reach. The company’s higher-than-average NIAT further illustrates its superior financial performance.

Additionally, Aboitiz Construction made a significant local economic impact, employing over 4,000 workers, with 91% locally hired. It also partnered with a government agency Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) to provide training in trades such as welding, pipefitting, and scaffolding.

As Aboitiz Construction celebrates its 50th anniversary in 2025, its focus on sustainability, safety, and innovation positions it for continued success, demonstrating industry leadership while driving national development.

Aboitiz Construction’s achievements since 2023 stand out as exceptional within the Philippine construction industry, which continues to grapple with delays, cost overruns, and low productivity. The World Bank (2020) has highlighted inefficient project management as a persistent issue leading to these setbacks. Against this backdrop, Aboitiz Construction’s 82% on-time project completion rate and 94% of projects delivered within target margins set a new benchmark for operational reliability. According to the Philippine Contractors Association (2022), these are two of the most pressing challenges for local players.

The company’s 27 million continuous safe man-hours and 100% customer satisfaction rate further elevate its position. In an industry plagued by occupational risks, Aboitiz Construction’s safety performance significantly exceeds norms (Philippine Department of Labor and Employment, 2021), reflecting its deep commitment to worker welfare and risk mitigation.

Its adoption of real-time remote monitoring and proprietary digital tools such as EquiMax addresses longstanding inefficiencies in project oversight. These innovations position the company as a frontrunner amid industry-wide calls for digital transformation (Philippine Development Plan, 2023). The result is a 30% increase in machine control equipment performance and enhanced project transparency.

Moreover, its growth in the maintenance segment—with 14 new clients and a projected ₱1 billion in revenue by 2026—demonstrates strategic foresight, differentiating it from competitors still focused on traditional builds. Together, these achievements underscore Aboitiz Construction’s leadership in redefining industry standards through operational excellence, innovation, and sustainability.
