In February 2023, we introduced a key upgrade featuring enhanced legal coverage for civil cryptographic devices and integrated real-time compliance tracking, reinforcing our legal accountability and transparency.

In May 2024, we further expanded the service with upgraded customs handling capabilities tailored for high-compliance ICT products, enabling faster, smoother clearance of sensitive technologies under Vietnam’s stringent regulations.

With these continuous enhancements, ExtendMax’s IOR/EOR service provides clients with a seamless, legally assured pathway to market access, empowering them to mitigate risks, accelerate entry, and stay fully compliant at every step.

By leveraging government-issued import licenses for sensitive products, we unlock market access that would otherwise be unattainable for many multinational companies. Clients trust us not only to move goods but to navigate one of Southeast Asia’s most challenging regulatory environments with precision, speed, and legal certainty.

In February 2023, we upgraded our IOR/EOR service with enhanced legal coverage for civil cryptographic devices and introduced a cloud-based compliance monitoring tool, enabling real-time tracking of licensing and shipments. Our client portfolio includes global names such as Palo Alto Networks, HPE, Axon, Infinera, Carrier Transicold, Sec Datacom, Foxconn, Pegatron, Arista, Sonion, Gebruder Weiss, Anton Paar, HMD, Flash Logistics, Choice Logistics, and Plus Logistics.

In 2024, the IOR/EOR service accounted for 36% of total company revenue, driving 60.3% year-over-year growth and delivering a 36% EBITDA margin, significantly surpassing the 15–20% industry average for legal consulting and 3PL logistics in Vietnam.
