Founded in 2015, [ExtendMax](#) has redefined what compliance means for global technology companies entering Vietnam. At a time when legal, certification, and logistics services operated in silos, CEO [Trần Thanh Phương](#) envisioned a bold solution: an integrated model combining Importer and Exporter of Record (IOR/EOR) services with full legal accountability. This pioneering approach positioned ExtendMax not just as an advisor, but as a partner who takes end-to-end responsibility for licensing, testing, customs clearance, and regulatory compliance—delivering clarity where others saw complexity.

In less than a decade, ExtendMax has transformed from a small consultancy into a trusted gateway for multinational corporations navigating Vietnam’s regulatory landscape, especially in high-stakes sectors like civil cryptography, cybersecurity, and radio frequency devices. By 2024, the firm had successfully delivered thousands of projects and served over 200 global clients, including Cisco, IBM, HPE, Nutanix, Siemens, Palo Alto, Samsung, LG, Fujitsu, Hitachi, Panasonic, Foxconn, Pegatron, Lenovo, Arista, Vitrox (Malaysia), Flash Global (US), and Choice Logistics (US). Today, ExtendMax is celebrated for its innovation, integrity, and unrivaled legal expertise, empowering businesses to turn compliance into a competitive advantage.

Since January 2023, ExtendMax has achieved remarkable growth and international recognition. In 2024, the company delivered 60.3% year-over-year growth with a 36% EBITDA margin. ExtendMax expanded its client base to over 200 global clients, delivered high-impact projects, and reinforced its leadership in compliance consulting in Vietnam.

A landmark achievement was supporting LEGO’s \$1.3 billion smart factory in Vietnam, the largest LEGO factory worldwide. ExtendMax acted as the legal [Importer of Record after LEGO's local entity](#) was ineligible for civil cryptography licenses. The company developed a compliance roadmap, secured licenses, coordinated testing, and completed importation. Thanks to ExtendMax’s end-to-end management, all IT systems were delivered on schedule with zero legal violations, enabling the factory to launch 60 days early and unlocking an estimated \$143 million in additional revenue.

In parallel, ExtendMax launched a cloud-based project management system to provide real-time compliance tracking and improve transparency. CEO Trần Thanh Phương also contributed as a legal expert in drafting a policy report submitted to the National Assembly through the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry, recommending regulatory improvements for ICT imports.

In 2025, ExtendMax became the first Vietnamese company to win the Asia-Pacific People’s Choice Stevie® Award for Favorite Companies. CEO Trần Thanh Phương was honored with the Gold [Stevie® Award for Innovative Achievement in Thought Leadership](#). The company also earned multiple international awards recognizing excellence in import-export services, compliance consulting, rapid growth, and outstanding leadership.

While traditional law firms, logistics providers, and testing labs deliver isolated services, ExtendMax became the first company in Vietnam to fully integrate the compliance process. This includes advisory, [licensing](#), testing, customs clearance, and post-clearance monitoring under a comprehensive IOR/EOR service model with full legal accountability. This innovative approach has redefined industry standards, transforming regulatory complexity into a strategic advantage for global businesses.

In an industry fragmented by silos, ExtendMax’s unified solution eliminated coordination gaps, minimized risks, and accelerated timelines. This achievement was exemplified by the flawless execution of LEGO’s \$1.3 billion smart factory project in Vietnam. ExtendMax successfully secured licenses, completed testing, and imported cryptographic IT equipment with full compliance and zero legal issues—an unprecedented outcome in comparable projects.

Financially, ExtendMax achieved 60.3% YOY revenue growth and a 36% EBITDA margin in 2024, outperforming the industry average of 15 - 20% for 3PL logistics and legal consulting firms in Vietnam. Beyond market leadership, ExtendMax contributed to shaping the legal landscape by co-authoring regulatory reforms through the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry. It is one of the few firms that both implements and influences national legal frameworks.

Winning the Asia-Pacific People’s Choice Stevie® Award and multiple international honors reflects the profound trust ExtendMax has earned from clients, partners, policymakers, and the global business community, reinforcing its position as an innovator, an influencer, and a trusted leader in legal compliance consulting.
