Vitalii Kostrub, founder and CEO of GBA TFreight Inc., is a pioneering entrepreneur whose leadership has redefined a vital segment of the U.S. agricultural logistics industry: the transportation of live bees. In less than a year since launching GBA TFreight in 2024, Vitalii has built the first fully structured, scalable commercial model for biologically sensitive freight, an innovation that is now essential to the national agricultural ecosystem.

Under his visionary guidance, GBA TFreight has grown from zero to **\$7–8 million** in annual revenue with **\$1.2–1.5 million** in net profit and more than **150 recurring clients** across all U.S. states. The company plays a crucial role in supporting crop pollination cycles directly impacting the yields of key crops such as almonds and sunflowers. No comparable service existed at this scale before Vitalii’s work.

The core of Vitalii’s achievement lies in developing a proprietary live bee transportation system that dramatically improves outcomes for beekeepers and farmers alike. Traditionally, transporting bee colonies by truck resulted in a 25–30% mortality rate due to inadequate handling of temperature, ventilation, and stress factors. Through his leadership, Vitalii reduced this rate to **less than 5%**, a game-changing result for pollination-dependent agriculture.

Vitalii’s innovations include:

- A **proprietary transportation methodology** based on climate zone routing, nighttime driving in warm areas, and customized driver behavior protocols.
- A **real-time GPS and ETA system** with biological risk monitoring—not just for efficiency but to actively protect cargo health.
- A **standardized driver instruction manual** and **comprehensive SOPs**—the first of their kind in this niche, now referenced by other logistics players.
- A **seasonally adaptive dispatch model** that aligns freight planning with crop cycles and veterinary regulations.

Vitalii’s system is now considered a new benchmark in the industry, enabling consistent, high-quality service during critical agricultural periods. His clients include **10 of the largest players in commercial beekeeping** and pollination, such as Soffel Honey Co., J & J Bee Service, B-Z Bee Pollination, and Browning’s Honey Co. Inc. The company maintains an extraordinary over **70% repeat client rate per season** and **over 90% client satisfaction rate**, underscoring its reputation for reliability and excellence.

Beyond the technical and operational achievements, Vitalii’s personal leadership style has been central to the company’s success. He manages all aspects of GBA TFreight hands-on: sales, business development, client relations, and operational oversight. His decision to prioritize long-term relationships over short-term profits has built unmatched client loyalty. In the company’s first year, he personally secured over **\$4 million** in direct contracts by delivering trust, transparency, and biological risk management, qualities rarely found in freight brokerage.

Vitalii also demonstrated exceptional organizational leadership by building an international, remote-first team across the U.S., Ukraine, Argentina, and Poland. This 24/7 operational model enables seamless management of time-sensitive, biologically sensitive shipments nationwide. His ability to design clear workflows and mentor cross-cultural teams has been a strategic asset, providing both resilience and scalability to the business.

Recognizing further growth opportunities, Vitalii expanded GBA TFreight’s expertise into adjacent markets, including the transportation of Christmas trees, livestock, and agricultural equipment cargoes with similar biological and seasonal sensitivity. This diversification has helped stabilize revenue streams and reduced dependency on a single market segment.

In a highly fragmented industry, Vitalii’s work stands apart. Before GBA TFreight, no structured, biologically informed logistics model existed for pollination-specific freight at scale in the U.S. Today, thanks to his vision and relentless execution, Vitalii’s company is the undisputed leader in this critical niche. His contribution goes beyond business success by helping safeguard pollination cycles, he supports the health of entire agricultural ecosystems and the nation’s food security.

Vitalii Kostrub’s entrepreneurial journey is a rare example of how deep expertise, bold innovation, and authentic leadership can transform an overlooked segment of the market into a strategic industry pillar. His achievements at GBA TFreight Inc. position him as one of the most impactful and forward-thinking entrepreneurs in agricultural logistics today.
