Trialt (pronounced Try-alt) is a global clinical research organization (CRO) specializing in biometrics-driven services, including biostatistics, statistical programming, data management, and medical writing. With team members across the U.S., Europe, and Asia, including Austria, Croatia, Poland, India, Israel, and Ukraine, Trialt delivers high-quality, efficient support to pharmaceutical and biotech sponsors worldwide.

Founded as a spinout of P-Product, a software engineering company established in 2005 by CEO Michael Vulikh, Trialt is built on a strong foundation of digital signal processing, AI/ML, and data-intensive systems. This highly-technical pedigree gives Trialt a unique edge: the precision and agility of a product development firm combined with the scientific rigor of a seasoned CRO.

Trialt is known for stepping in when timelines are tight and quality cannot be compromised. In one notable rescue study, Trialt was engaged with only three weeks to deliver 72 TLFs and compliant datasets after a previous vendor failed. Using automated workflows, parallel tasking, and a 24/7 expert team, all deliverables were submitted on time and passed quality control on the first attempt. That ability to deliver under pressure has earned Trialt the trust of sponsors across the globe and positioned the organization as a high-performance partner.

In this time, Trialt has significantly advanced pharma industry innovation by helping clients harness the power of generative AI to solve some of the industry's most complex data challenges. A standout example is our work with Market4Health.io, a pioneering platform built to streamline market access operations using cutting-edge AI technology.

Market access professionals face mounting challenges in navigating payer documentation, regulatory changes, and classification codes. Trialt collaborated with Market4Health.io to design and launch a generative AI-powered solution that:

- Automates cataloging of 50,000+ payer policy documents
- Tracks the historical evolution of regulations
- Uses Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG) for intuitive, human-language search
- Enables AI-based ICD and classification code annotation
- Generates automatic summaries and shareable compliance reports

Since launch, Market4Health.io clients have reported more than 60% reduction in manual effort and a massive 70% improvement in information retrieval speed. Trialt's work in this way has been instrumental in turning regulatory overload into strategic, actionable intelligence.

This collaboration uniquely showcases Trialt's growing industry leadership in bringing transformative AI applications to the pharma and biotech sectors and helping sponsors work faster, smarter, and with greater accuracy.

Trialt's achievements are significant because they go beyond standard service delivery and demonstrate a capacity to lead with innovation and precision in critical, high-stakes environments. Our collaboration with Market4Health.io, for instance, has redefined what's possible in the market access space. While many organizations in our industry are still evaluating how to apply AI, Trialt successfully deployed a generative AI-powered platform that handles more than 50,000 payer policy documents. Features such as Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG), automatic ICD annotation, and historical tracking of regulatory changes deliver real-time, human-language interaction leading to a 60% reduction in manual effort and a 70% improvement in data retrieval speed. This level of performance is far beyond what legacy systems or manual review processes can achieve.

Equally impactful is our work scaling a statistical programming team for a large CRO. Tasked with deploying 12 senior programmers within three months, Trialt created a custom onboarding and training framework informed by our experience training more than 100 programmers over four years. The result was a fully integrated, high-performing team that achieved productivity in just 6–8 weeks, significantly faster than typical industry timelines. This case shows Trialt's ability to deliver speed and quality simultaneously, without compromising compliance or operational continuity.

Together, these examples highlight Trialt's differentiated position in the market. We are going beyond the average CRO to build intelligent, scalable solutions that allow sponsors and partners to move faster, meet urgent demands, and set a new standard for delivery across the pharma and biotech landscape.
