Dr. Phone Fix is a telecommunications leader in keeping Canadians connected through the most important technical innovation of our times - the cell phone. It's estimated that 600 Canadians break their phones every hour - interrupting their use for banking, shopping, navigating, entertainment, work, school and more. Through its 35 stores in 23 cities in 4 Canadian provinces, it fixes them. Launched in 2019, it's an internationally recognized award-winning, eco-friendly, customer-centric growth leader in Canada's multi-million dollar cell phone repair and resell industry, repairing more phones than almost anybody in Canada and is its second biggest reseller of certified pre-owned phones diverting them from landfills.

It's mission is 'Repair, Reuse, Refurbish, Resell, Recycle'. It's built a major supply chain enabling its stores to do repairs quickly - usually in under an hour. Repairs carry a lifetime warranty. It has service agreements with Samsung and Apple and is a partner with a top recycler. It has 28,000 verified positive online reviews. It's won 8 Stevie gold trophies and was chosen Stevie People's Choice winner (in 2024.2023). It was Canada's largest corporately-owned company in the category until it went public on the Toronto Venture Stock Exchange in 2025.


