With teacher shortages at critical levels and a lack of educator representation compared to student populations, Study.com identified an opportunity to make test preparation more accessible, personalized and effective for aspiring teachers.

The AI-powered Praxis Core Test Prep helps aspiring teachers gain the skills and confidence needed to pass their licensure exams through several key features: personalized learning plans tailored to individual strengths and weaknesses; video-based micro lessons catered to various learning styles; AI-powered diagnostic tools identifying areas for improvement and guiding test takers through targeted study sessions; multi-module options for differentiated learning, accommodating diverse learning styles, English Language Learners (ELL), and translation; and interactive quizzes with instant feedback to reinforce learning and save educators' valuable time.

This free test prep is part of Study.com's broader "Keys to the Classroom" initiative, which helps remove financial and accessibility barriers for aspiring educators in more than 20 states. A November 2024 study across Study.com, TEACH and ETS found that sufficient use of Study.com for teacher test prep was associated with higher pass rates among Praxis test-takers, especially candidates of color and those retaking the test.

The research examined test results and pass rates over 18 months for 2,557 teacher candidates who took a Praxis exam after their TEACH start date. The study demonstrated direct impact on the educator workforce, showing that targeted intervention and support work, especially among priority populations with historically lower pass rates on certification exams.

Specific results highlight the significance: In North Carolina, Black teacher candidates who retook the Praxis exam following sufficient use of Study.com for test prep had a 1.5x higher pass rate than those with limited use. Teacher candidates with temporary or conditional licenses in North Carolina had a 38% higher pass rate with sufficient use of Study.com. While Praxis exam re-takers tend to pass at lower rates, re-takers with sufficient use of Study.com had 1.7X higher pass rates in North Carolina and 13% higher pass rates in South Carolina.

These outcomes address the dual challenges of teacher shortages and the need to broaden representation across the profession. While school districts struggle with these issues, the free Praxis Core Test Prep provides teacher candidates with an accessible, personalized study resource to strengthen their reading, writing, and math skills to pass the certification exam, creating measurable pathways for underrepresented populations to enter the profession.
