Since July 1, 2023, Crystal has led MUSC's digital transformation initiatives to measurable, enterprise-wide impact:

- **Voice Technology Launch:** Led the successful launch of a voice-enabled digital assistant, now handling over 15% of inbound patient calls, improving access, and reducing staff burden.
- **Breast Cancer Outreach Campaign:** Oversaw an AI-driven initiative that led to 3930 appointments booked for self-scheduled mammograms and identified 210 abnormal findings, accelerating early detection and treatment.
- **Care Gap Closures:** Used robotic process automation to trigger over 110,000 personalized patient outreach messages each month, significantly improving appointment rates and preventive care adherence.
- **Pre-Visit Experience Success:** Improved pre-registration satisfaction to 97%, and supported over 2,000 Spanish-speaking encounters with AI-enabled translation tools for patients and saved 3-5 minutes per patient for the healthcare office team.
- **Recognition and Influence:** Named a Top 100 Global Chief Digital Officer, Crystal has influenced national conversations on digital health through speaking engagements, roundtables, and publications.

In addition, she has championed low-code/no-code AI development, empowering non-technical staff to create and deploy workflows that accelerate care delivery and operational efficiency.

Crystal Broj is the inaugural Chief Digital Transformation Officer at the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC), a multi-hospital academic health system serving hundreds of thousands of patients annually. With a background spanning healthcare, insurance, and nonprofit leadership, Crystal brings a rare blend of business acumen and human-centered design to healthcare innovation. Since joining MUSC in 2022, she has built a high-performing team from the ground up and led transformative efforts that have touched nearly every corner of the enterprise.

Her past achievements include designing a national award-winning diabetes tech website, leading mobile app strategy for a major health system, and mentoring future leaders across industries. She has spoken at national conferences including HIMSS, HLTH, ViVE, and Becker's, offering a unique voice at the intersection of digital transformation, clinical care, and operational excellence. Crystal is not only a builder of systems—but of people, culture, and momentum.

Her leadership model is also exceptional: She built MUSC's digital transformation team from scratch, strategically integrating RPA, AI, ambient technology, and real-time analytics into existing workflows. This has resulted in **millions in reimbursement, double-digit improvements in no-show rates**, and national visibility for MUSC.

Compared to peers, Crystal's team accomplishes more with fewer resources by focusing on **platform thinking**, agile execution, and frontline empowerment. Her leadership fosters cross-functional collaboration among IT, clinical, research, and administrative teams—breaking down silos that often hinder innovation in large health systems.

Crystal is not just implementing digital tools—she is redefining what transformation looks like in academic medicine.
