Inflo Health has achieved major milestones in product validation, global recognition, and measurable clinical impact. In early 2024, Inflo Health was selected by the ACR to join its prestigious Learning Network Vendor Partner Program. This honor followed the successful implementation at East Alabama Medical Center (EAMC), where Inflo Health's AI-powered platform helped increase follow-up imaging adherence by 74% and reduced coordination workload by 95%.

The ACR recognition was both a validation of Inflo Health's results and a springboard for broader impact. Through this partnership, Inflo Health is now contributing to nationwide efforts to improve quality in radiology and reduce missed follow-ups, a known contributor to delayed diagnosis and lost revenue across U.S. hospitals.

At the same time, Inflo Health has expanded its footprint across 11 major hospitals, hospital systems, and imaging center networks and deepened its EHR integration capabilities. Internally, the company has strengthened its engineering and clinical support teams, enhanced its LLM for greater accuracy in unstructured radiology text, and doubled down on clinician-centric design.

In June 2025, Inflo Health was selected as the Global Winner for Excellence in AI at the Digital Revolution Awards, a powerful recognition of the impact that human-centered AI can have in transforming healthcare and improving patient outcomes.

Founded in 2021, Inflo Health is a healthcare technology company dedicated to closing critical gaps in radiology follow-up care. Led by CEO Angela Adams—a former Duke ICU nurse turned health tech entrepreneur—Inflo Health was born from a personal and widespread problem: missed radiology follow-ups that lead to delayed or missed diagnoses and compromised outcomes.

Drawing on deep clinical knowledge and AI expertise, Inflo Health developed a proprietary natural language processing (NLP) platform to identify follow-up recommendations in radiology reports in real-time and route them for timely, automated action. The solution integrates directly into clinical workflows, reducing the burden on staff while increasing patient safety and system revenue.

Inflo's impact is already being felt across major health systems. Its work with East Alabama Medical Center, the first client to validate Inflo Health's outcomes through the American College of Radiology (ACR), resulted in a 74% increase in follow-up adherence, 20% improvement in compliance with Fleischner Society Guidelines, and a 95% reduction in manual coordination—evidence that smart, practical technology can deliver lasting change.

Backed by experienced healthcare investors and a women-led leadership team, Inflo Health pushes the boundaries of what's possible when technology is built to serve clinicians, patients, and quality improvement.

Inflo Health's achievements are particularly significant in a healthcare AI landscape where many tools overpromise and underdeliver—or worse, complicate existing workflows. Inflo Health has taken a targeted, high-impact approach: using AI to close radiology follow-up gaps, a problem that affects more than 50% of cases nationally, according to the ACR.

What sets Inflo Health apart is its foundation in high-reliability organization (HRO) principles—proven strategies used in complex industries where failure isn't an option. From the start, the Inflo team was laser-focused on understanding and eliminating the failure points that cause missed follow-up care. That mindset shaped every element of the solution: disciplined design, risk-mitigating analytics and alerts, AI deployed where it delivers the most trusted impact, and a relentless focus on elevating the human side of care. As a result, Angela and her team have built a system that minimizes process gaps and empowers clinical teams to operate at their highest level.

Inflo Health's selection into the ACR Learning Network is an important endorsement. Fewer than a dozen vendors are invited, and inclusion signifies trust, clinical rigor, and alignment with national quality goals. At East Alabama Medical Center, Inflo's platform helped close over 85% of open follow-up loops—far surpassing industry benchmarks.

Compared to its own footprint just a year ago, Inflo has significantly grown its hospital partnerships, technical capabilities, and industry influence. It's a standout performer among health AI startups, and one of the few that's women-led at the executive level.
